onths or weeks before your starting date begin to announce the opening of your Bible Institute in all your services. Let the church members know that everyone who has finished high school (and can read and understand English) is welcome to attend. It's free

to church members and at night so all can come. Be enthusiastic! Tell them it will make them a better Christian, a better church member, a better Sunday School teacher, a better Deacon, a better Christian worker. Our oldest graduate was 85 years old. Announce it often and always with

enthusiasm.

We begin with a reception for all who are thinking about coming. Make it special with food of some kind being served - the room decorated with banners, program sheets (see page 27 in the BI Handbook).

Go over your rules and regulations (save demerit explanation for orientation or first class session - too negative for the reception). Challenge them with a special speaker and answer questions at some point during the meeting. Plan special music.

### TO ALL BIBLE INSTITUTE PRESIDENTS:

This new suggested schedule has been arranged to make it as interesting for the students as possible. We have re-named O.T. Survey in line with the new material. Alternating subjects instead of teaching the same thing several blocks in a row will help to keep it from becoming boring for teacher and students.

A subject is learned better when it is taught one day a week for four weeks. We have re-arranged the third year with this in mind - to minimize the two week Tue/Thur subjects. Avoid doing this in the first and second years altogether. Avoid one week subjects unless the Browns or other outside speakers are coming in to teach. Other teachers you use should live close enough to be able to follow the four week schedule. Get suggestions from BAMA for teachers for Music and Finances.

We trust this will help you in setting up your B.I. schedule each year. We are praying for your schools and for you as you "keep on keeping on" for the glory of the Lord.
