Truths Every Christian Needs to Know

SCRIPTURE MEMORY

"But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou obtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth." 1 Timothy 3:15

What we believe about the church must come from God's Word. The Bible is the sole authority for faith and practice in the New Testament church. Let us ask, "What is the church?"

The word "church" is significant in the Bible because it is never used to refer to a denomination or to a group of churches. It is never used to describe a national church. The Bible teaches that a church is a local assembly of baptized believers who have voluntarily joined themselves together to carry out the Great Commission.

Read Matthew 16:13-18. When Peter declared, "Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God;" the Lord Jesus said, "Upon this rock I will build my church." He is the Builder of the church. We must understand that the Lord Jesus is doing His work in this world through the local church. Let us serve God by finding our place in the local church.

The New Testament Church Started With Christ and His Disciples and Was Empowered at Pentecost

Christ gave the Great Commission to the church.

Consider Matthew 18:15-17. Jesus Christ started the church with His disciples. When we realize

this, we see that the Lord gave the Great Commission to the church, not simply a group of followers. Baptism and the Lord's Supper are not ministerial ordinances; they are local church ordinances.

The New Testament Church Has a Saved Membership

Read Acts 2:41-42. The local church, as we find it in God's Word, is made up of people who have been saved and obeyed the Lord in believer's baptism. Every Christian should belong to a local Bible-believing church.

The New Testament Church Has Christ as the Only Head

Colossians 1:18 teaches that Christ is the only head of the church. A Baptist church recognizes that it has only one headquarters, and that is heaven. The Bible teaches that every church should be directly accountable to Christ, not to a denomination or group of churches.

The New Testament Church Is an Independent Congregation

Notice in Acts 13:1-4 that this local church sent out missionaries. The Bible teaches that each church should be self-governing and self-supporting.

The New Testament Church Is Responsible to Evangelize the World

Acts 1:8 reveals to us that the local church is to reach the entire

world with the gospel. A New Testament church has taken seriously God's command for world evangelism. Find your place of service in the local New Testament Church!

The New Testament Church Is Pastor-led
