My insurance company, who has provided caregivers for me for seven years, has declared me to be "physically fit" to where I do not need their services any longer. I believe their assessment was correct because I am feeling much better now than I have in the past two years. What can I say but praise be to our Wonderful God and Savior Jesus Christ. I will be traveling alone, with the Lord of course.

I do have one concern that I would like you to pray about, my eyes. I have had macular degeneration for some time now and I need special care for them. I had laser surgery done on my right eye to clean the implant and it has improved the eyesight in that eye a lot. New glasses were prescribed and now I am able to see more clearly. PTL!

At this writing I am packing up my belongings for my next departure May 1st. to the Philippines. My schedule is filled to the brim until I return to the States November 5th. Here's a brief list of things I will be doing while there:

1. I will have a part in our Pastors and Workers Camp starting May 13th.

2. Once the camp is over I will be moving to Banaue, about an 8 to 10 hour drive North, where the famous Rice Terrace are. I will be doing evangelistic work there until July 1st. I will be taking along with me one of our graduates from our Bible College in Manila to assist me in this undertaking. It will be personal soul-winning, door to door.

3. After Banaue, I will return to Manila to relieve a Pastor for four months while he and his wife leave the country. This church has a full program of services: Sunday School, Morning and evening services, Wednesday Prayer service, and activities.



4. In addition to the above, I will be preaching in many other locations as time permits.

I love what I am doing; preaching, teaching and winning the lost to Jesus Christ. This has been my purpose and passion in my life since 1966 and I plan to continue on fulfilling my purpose until Jesus takes me home to be with Him forever.
