

MULTIPLICITY OF BIBLES - TOOL IN THE STRUGGLE AGAINST FUNDAMENTALISM

In promoting a new edition of the ecumenical French Bible, the **head** of the World Council of Churches observed that it is good to have a multiplicity of Bibles. At the presentation ceremony in Geneva, Sam Kobia, WCC general secretary, said: "*Having a variety of translations available encourages the Bible to be read in a plural and ecumenical way. Having a variety of translations available is a precious tool in the struggle against religious fundamentalism,*" (ENI, Jan. 23). Thus we see that the liberals and ecumenists understand that the huge variety of Bible versions works against biblical fundamentalism by weakening the authority of the Scriptures.
