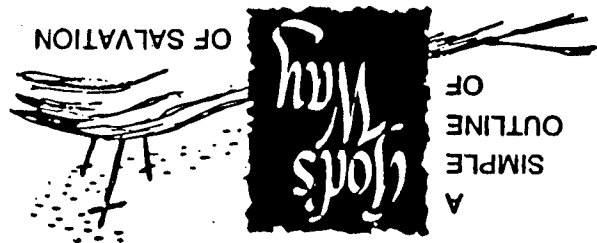


- II. Can I Be Saved?**
- A. Yes, for God sent His Son to be your Saviour. "Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us, and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins" (1 John 4:10).
- B. Man is sinful. "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23).
- C. Sin separates man from God. "But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid His face from you..." (Isaiah 59:2).
- D. It is impossible for man to save himself. "...that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God... by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in His sight..." (Romans 3:19,20).
- III. How Can I Be Saved?**
- A. God is holy, and no sin will ever enter His presence. "...the Lord our God is holy" (Psalm 99:9).
- B. Acknowledge your sinfulness before a holy God. "But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us..." we shall be saved from wrath through Him" (Romans 5:8,9).
- C. Receive the living Christ into your heart as your very own. "...I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me" (John 14:6).
- D. Confess the Lord Jesus before men. "...if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved" (Romans 10:9).
- IV. Have You Made This Important Decision?**
- A. You need wait no longer because "...behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation" (II Corinthians 6:2).
- II. Do I Need To Be Saved?**
- A. God is holy, and no sin will ever enter His presence. "...the Lord our God is holy" (Psalm 99:9).

- III. How Can I Be Saved?**

- B. Receive the living Christ into your heart as your very own. "...I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me" (John 14:6).
- C. Confess the Lord Jesus before men. "...if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved" (Romans 10:9).
- IV. Have You Made This Important Decision?**
- A. You need wait no longer because "...behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation" (II Corinthians 6:2).

- B. You need not wait until you are a better person, because Jesus said "...I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance" (Mark 2:17).
- C. You need not wait for an unusual experience. Salvation is by faith in what God says. "Verily, verily [truly, truly], I say unto you, he that heareth My word, and believeth on Him that sent Me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life" (John 5:24).
