

You may say you do not believe all this, but that does not alter facts. "...who art thou that repliest against God?" (Romans 9:20). "...he that believeth not God hath made Him a liar..." (1 John 5:10). The responsibility of spending eternity in Hell is yours and yours alone. If you are not concerned about your own soul and have no desire to be saved, pass this leaflet on to someone else. He may thank you for the warning and be saved.

You cannot say there is plenty of time to settle this matter: For God says: "...behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation" (1 Corinthians 6:2).

You cannot say you keep the law: For God says: "For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all" (James 2:10). The law was given to show their need of a Saviour. "...the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth us from all sin" (1 John 1:7).

You cannot say: "I am doing the best I can." I have turned over a new leaf and joined the church. "I have a good heart; I will trust in the Lord for the rest." "God is too good to punish me in Hell," or "I have done nothing of Hell." God says: "...all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags..." (Isaiah 64:6). "Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us..." (Titus 3:5).

You cannot say you have not been warned: For this little silent messenger containing God's Word is your warning and it may be your last. Search the Scriptures and see if these things are so.

You are left without an excuse: "...they are without excuse" (Romans 1:20). Where will you spend eternity? "...if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved" (Romans 10:9).

Being convinced that I am a sinner, and believing that Christ died for me, I now receive Him as my personal Saviour, and with His help I intend to confess Him before men.

"But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name" (John 1:12).
